Veterans Pride Battalion (VPB) is a Navy Sea Cadet unit based in Glendale, Arizona, and operates out of the Glendale Armory. Our core mission is to provide youth members with opportunities to develop their leadership skills, build character and become productive citizens. Drill weekends are held monthly, much like an adult reserve unit, along with other scheduled special event activities with a focus on service to the community. Two-week summer and winter training sessions are also available. Cadets wear authorized Navy uniforms appropriately marked with NSCC/NLCC insignia.

All new cadets join Veterans Pride Battalion at the rate of Seaman Recruit and are required to attend NSCC Recruit Training, better known as boot camp. This initial training is a scaled-down version of the Navy's boot camp. New cadets are instructed by active and reserve military personnel and Sea Cadet officers in military drill and discipline, physical fitness, seamanship, shipboard safety, first aid, naval history, and leadership. After cadets have successfully completed boot camp, they can then participate in advanced training which covers a wide gamut of interests and ability levels.



Membership requirements are as follows:

- Be between the ages of 10 and 17
- Must be a US Citizen
- Be a full time student and maintain satisfactory grades
- Be free of felony convictions
