NOTES:

We have our annual inspection in March and this is part of your responsibility to ensure your most recent report card is in your file.
- Ens Riley will be reviewing the demerit program again and handing out the write up on the PRO/CON reports.
- The unit will be providing lunch on Saturday at no charge.
- If you are not going to be at drill, please let your chain of command know as soon as possible so we have the correct amount of food. Also, remember that Sea Cadets is a commitment and we need you to attend drill. Missing drills will negatively affect your PRO/CON report and could put you in risk of not getting credit for the year. Also, for those of you who attend every drill, you will receive a perfect attendance award during our end of the year Annual Banquet.

- Hydrate, hydrate, hydrate!! Make sure you bring a water bottle, canteen or camelpack with you.
- Make sure you have a hair cut if needed.
